Cochrane Training Courses

'Introduction to Cochrane' – This half-day course will train people with little or no previous experience to access and use the Cochrane Library. The course will improve the participants' knowledge of evidence-based healthcare and will cover the principles and practice of Cochrane systematic reviews.

'Cochrane Systematic Review Course' – This intensive two-day course will cover systematic review methodologies and critical appraisal skills. The course is suitable for individuals who require a more detailed knowledge of systematic reviews and who may be thinking of conducting a systematic review themselves.

Cochrane Fellowships

The aim of the Cochrane Fellowships is to build capacity in conducting systematic reviews in the health and social care field in Ireland by freeing up protected time for successful applicants to conduct a Cochrane systematic review in a topic of their choice.
